Since he was 10, 21-year-old Brock Butler had been battling an autoimmune disease that affects the liver called Primary Sclerosing Cholangitis (PSC); its only resolve is a liver transplant. Eight days after his birthday in 2012, Brock died waiting for a transplant.

While Brock's family journeyed through their grief, they decided to do something positive in Brock's memory and create the BrockStrong Foundation. "We raise money to provide private music lessons for children who could not otherwise afford it, and we are also trying to raise awareness of the need for organ donation."

The BrockStrong 5K Fun Run/Walk is scheduled for June 9 at Wheeler Farm. In addition to the fun run, the foundation is also hosting the BrockStrong Music Festival on August 24.
