cidentals. She also writes freelance for publications including The Washington Post, Huffington Post, The St. Petersburg Times, The Performing Songwriter, and Delta "Sky" Magazine. In November 2011 her book COLD PIZZA FOR BREAKFAST: A MEM-WHA?? won the 43rd Annual ASCAP Deems Taylor Award for excellence in nonfiction writing about pop music. Christine has also won five ASCAP composer awards, the Backstage Bistro Award for Best NYC Singer/Songwriter Of The Year, The Kate Wolf Memorial Award, and her album *Good Thing He Can't* Read My Mind won Album Of The Year from the National Association Of Independent Record Distributors. She collaborates with many other songwriters and performers and has been an integral part of contemporary songwriting. She is humorous, some would say hilarious, and loves to share her craft with others.

Each year, the academy brings in a new guest instructor to co-teach with Utah's **Kate MacLeod**.

Kate is a musician and songwriter who performs across the country and into Europe. Her songs have been performed and recorded by various artists from California to the Czech Republic in many roots music genres. Working with a different guest instructor creates a new experience every year for the IAMA Songwriter Academy. There will be discussions of the nuts and bolts of songwriting, a performance workshop, a class on creating a music video with your iPhone, and song sharing/critique sessions.

meet and greet event on Thursday, June 20th, 7pm, at *Ken Sanders Rare Books*. Classes are scheduled from 9am-6pm on June 21st at the Salt Lake City Public Library. Song critiquing/sharing will continue on Sat 22nd with Kate MacLeod.

David Parmley & Cardinal Tradition

David Parmley & Cardinal Tradition are back and will be in concert again at The South Valley Unitarian Church located at 6876 Highland Dr on Friday June 14.

David Parmley began his musical career at age 15 and by the time he turned 17, he began his full time career as a member of *The Bluegrass Cardinals*, which featured his father, Don Parmley, and three Los

Angeles musicians.
David's lead and baritone voice was the backbone to The Cardinal sound.
The Bluegrass Cardinals recorded dozens of projects during their 25 year run. The material is considered the finest to come out of the 70's and 80's Bluegrass era. David

left The Bluegrass Cardinals in the 90's to pursue a solo career featuring a more modern approach to Bluegrass Music. *David Parmley and Continental Divide* topped the Bluegrass Charts throughout the 90's. He took time off the road around 2008, but in 2016 returned to Bluegrass Music with a new renewed spirit. *Cardinal Tradition* is an exciting new adventure and one that everyone has been waiting for.

The band members are David

Parmley/Guitar, Dale Perry/Banjo, Steve Day/Fiddle, Shane Bartley/Mandolin and Ron Spears/Bass. This quintet has over 180 years of experience performing in the Bluegrass genre. As the name suggests, this band is bringing back the songs and sounds of The Bluegrass Cardinals. The Cardinals were at the top of the Bluegrass heap from 1976 to 1991. They will be bringing back the smooth three and four part harmonies the Cardinals were renowned for. They are also creating new recordings featuring great old Bluegrass Cardinal classics and new songs that fit perfectly with the originals.






